### DATA PROTECTION AND GDPR

**Sick List** - Because of new data protection guidelines, parishioners must supply written consent before being added to the sick list published in the newsletter.

If an adult does not have the mental capacity to consent, a close family member can give consent on their behalf.

**Rotas** - Volunteers for Sunday and weekday rotas must now give written consent before the rota can be displayed in church. Telephone numbers are not listed on rotas but contact numbers are kept in a safe place.
