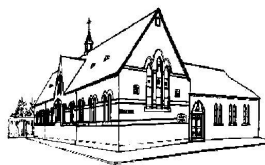

smile as much as we all do at this moment in time.

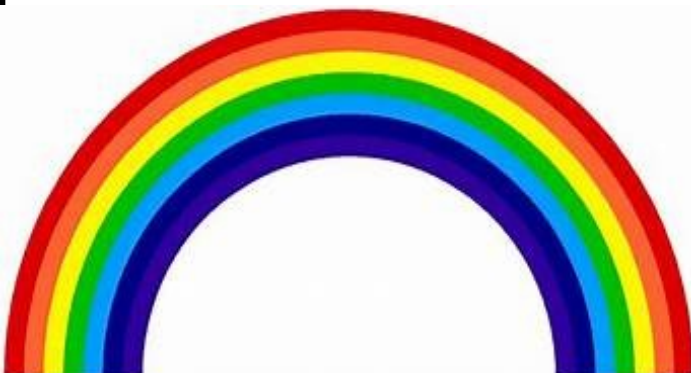
