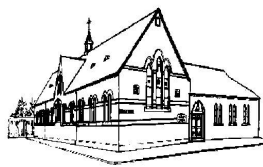

Bishop Robert Byrne CO has announced the re-opening of a further 20 Churches for Private Prayer only.
