PASSION FLOWERS

The flower is full of symbolism.
The 3 stamens represent; the 3 nails
which pierced Jesus' hands and
feet, or the 3 crosses of Jesus and
the 2 thieves.
The circle of 10 petals symbolise;
Jesus' crown of thorns.
The leaves represent the spear that went into the side of Jesus.
The Passion Flower normally lasts for three days and reminds
us of the 3 days Jesus spent in the tomb.



Some of the guidelines and instructions provided by the
Catholic Bishop's Conference for our Easter Services.

**TODAY PALM SUNDAY - Palms to be blessed in Church
and distributed to the congregation in a safe way at the end of
Mass with less handling.**
Shorter form of the Passion to be read with or without multiple
readers and the turbo parts should not be exclaimed by the
congregation.

There will be no procession and no blessing of the congregation
with Holy Water on Palm Sunday or Easter Sunday.

No Altar of Repose this year.

No Veneration of the cross on Good Friday
