

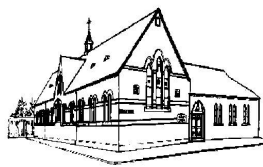

YOU DON'T NEED TO BOOK A PLACE FOR SUNDAY MASS

AT ST WILLIAM'S but we must still follow certain rules.

Hand sanitiser - use of hand sanitiser entering & leaving church and before liturgies should continue.

Face Coverings - all those attending Church are asked to wear a face covering unless exempt from doing so.

Social Distancing & Capacity of Churches - reduced church capacities based on a minimum of 1M spacing between households should continue.
